The cost of the workshop includes the new VEX V5 Classroom Starter Kit, including a robot kit, motors, V5 Brain and V5 Controller, which will not, unfortunately, be available until after school starts. Since the rollout of VEX V5 kits has been pushed into September, you will receive it as soon as it is available. Robot Mesh will be doing the inservice training, and the focus will be on programming a VEX V5 robot using both real and virtual robots, with Drag-N-Drop Blockly and Python programming. We will also talk about the VEX Robotics Competition (VRC) and the TSA-VEX Challenge.

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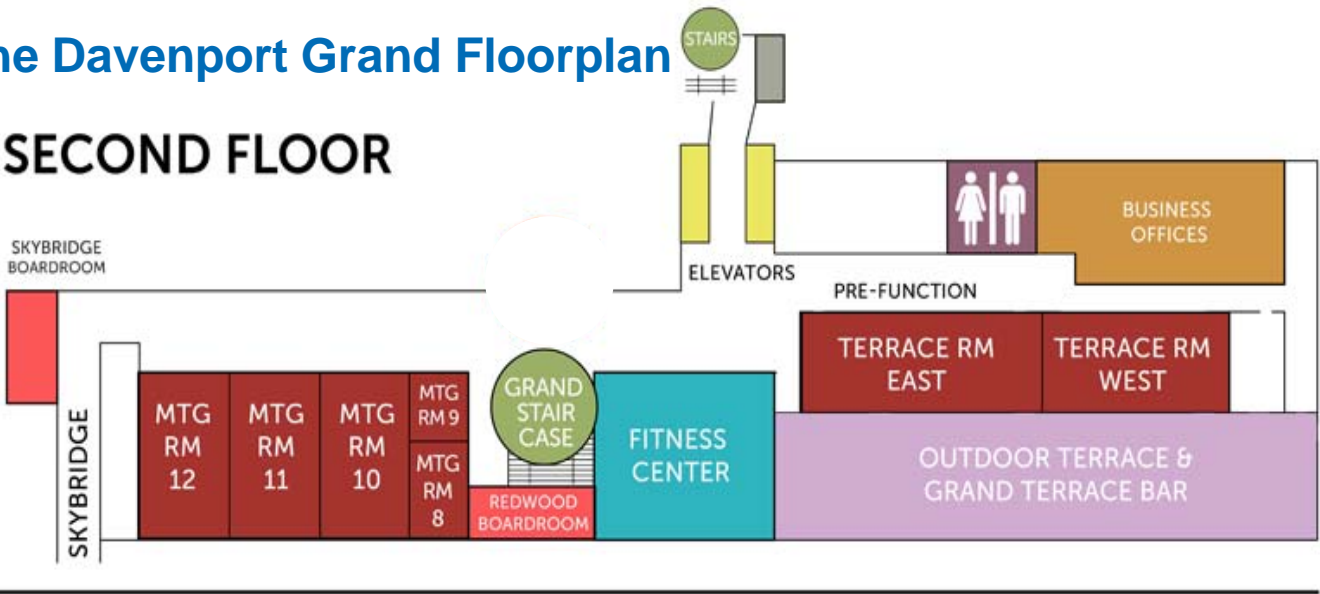

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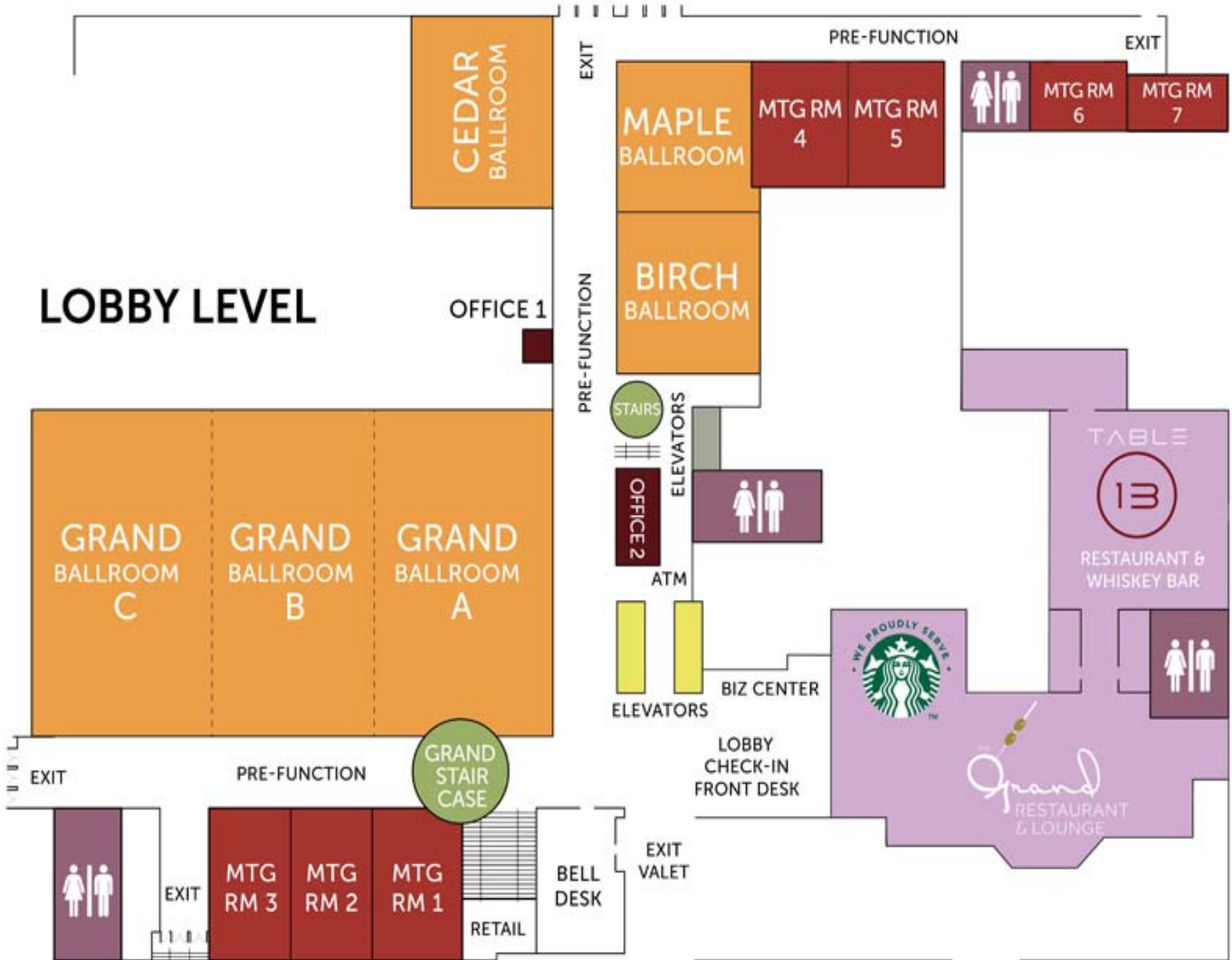
