Photography Teacher (1.0 FTE) @ WHS (048-CRT-03/13)

DESCRIPTION: Prepare individuals to use artistic techniques to effectively communicate ideas and information to business and consumer audiences, by recording events, things and people, via digital, film and still photography. This includes instruction in specialized camera and equipment operation; maintenance and use of computer applications to support these functions; applications to commercial and industrial needs; photography career and business operations. This position includes work with active student leadership included in all curriculums and through the SkillsUSA organization; effectively maintains program instructional equipment and supplies; and detailed, time-bound reporting to satisfy building, district, state and Federal requirements. Plan, develop, implement and evaluate classroom instruction consistent with building, district and state curriculum and instructional framework. Report pupil progress to parents; support programs and building/district in-service education programs; attend building/district meetings and conferences as required. Other related duties as assigned.

Visual/Graphic Arts Teacher

Description Plan, develop, and implement classroom instruction and contract development consistent with building and district curriculum. This teaching assignment may include two or three disciplines within the visual/graphic arts arena. The teacher is responsible for student learning, classroom based assessment creation, reporting progress to parents in a timely fashion, and aligning the curriculum to the state standards.
