

The paper, titled "Defining High-quality CTE: Contemporary Perspectives on CTE Quality," identifies commonalities among the many voices in the national discussion of high-quality CTE, and lays the groundwork to fuse their ideas into the development of a singular framework that could guide leaders from the education and policy communities in developing the next generation of CTE learning.


