HOUSE BILLS

[House Bill 1561: Concerning open educational resources](#)

The amendment passed: Adds a sunset clause to the OER grant program. Makes the open educational resources project permanent.

[House Bill 1896: Expanding civics education in public schools](#)

The amendment passed: Removes the null and void clause.

[House Bill 2143: Expanding opportunities for higher education students](#)

The amendment passed: Modifies the name of the account to the Advanced Degrees Pathways Account. Requires that state match funds transferred into the Advanced Degrees Pathways Account cannot exceed \$1 million per biennium. Makes technical corrections.

[House Bill 2748: Modifying the learning assistance program](#)

The amendment passed: (1) During the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school years only, school districts may expend a portion of the district's LAP allocation to develop a Dropout Early Warning and Intervention Data System. (2) Allows school districts to expend LAP allocations on student interventions for students identified as at risk of not graduating.

[House Bill 2824: Exchanging and aligning specific powers, duties, and functions of the superintendent of public instruction and the state board of education](#)

The amendment passed: (1) Removes the requirement for the State Board of Education and the Superintendent of Public Instruction (SPI) to review available and appropriate options for expanding the integration of competency-based education practices in public schools and to provide a report to the education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate by November 1, 2019. (2) Adds a requirement for the SPI to review available and appropriate options for competency-based assessments that meet the essential academic learning requirements and provide a report and recommendations to the education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate by November 1, 2019.
