

# **WOVE Legislative Update for Career and Technical Education**

**Legislative Session Week 20 – 2015 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Session  
May 29, 2015**

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## **LAST DAY OF FIRST SPECIAL SESSION**

May 28 was the last day of the first special session (135 days total) Senate Ways and Means passed a “new” budget bill from committee. The CTE MSOC correction WAS NOT included in the new [SB 6050](#) language.

This is the Senate’s formal proposal over to the House, who has been holding fast to their proposed budget as outlined in [HB 1106](#).

We still have not been able to get one of the chambers to officially move on our request for the CTE MSOC correction language.

## **SECOND SPECIAL SESSION BEGINS**

In 2013, there were three sessions to pass a final budget that lasted up to the “11<sup>th</sup> hour” of the last day to pass the budget or begin shutting down state functions. A shutdown has never happened, but with the entrenched positions of each party we could very well go to the bitter end.

U.S.G.A. Open Championship puts pressure on the legislative calendar. With the US Open in Tacoma June 15-21 creates an outside pressure for legislators and staff due to a lack of “housing” that week. The talk has been to be done by June 12 or the need to just have the required skeleton crew here to continue working that week. This may mean the loss of those 7 days out of the final 30 days. If a golf tournament will move the work along sooner then all the better.

## **SO WHAT DOES THAT MEAN GOING FORWARD NOW?**

It is not over until it is over. There is still a path to achieve the CTE MSOC correction this legislative session. We, along with your help, continue to talk to Senate and House leaders to have the language included. They are very unwilling to expand K-12 funding by \$38M at this time. While wanting to be supportive of CTE they may choose to use a lower dollar amount.

Your role continues to be critical in our success! You and your district leadership need to continue to contact your local state legislators and make them aware of the future negative impact that your district will incur if the CTE MSOC correction is not adopted. We have many legislators who are willing to vote for an increase to CTE MSOC if their leadership will bring the issue forward. As you talk with them, seek their commitment to support the correction and to ask their leadership to bring it to the floor.
