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WOVE Final Issue of 2015 - Operating Budget Passage June 30, 2015

- Increases K-12 funding by \$1.3 billion
- Funds full-day Kindergarten for all students
- Raises teacher pay
- Shrinks college tuition by 15%
- Reduces class sizes in grades K-3
- Grows early learning funding by \$158 million
- Provides high-quality preschool for 1,600 additional students

ZERO increase provided for CTE MSOC - funding levels continue as is in current law.
