



## **WAVE Scholarship Update**

Winners Announced in June

The Workforce Board announced 121 winners for the Washington Award for Vocational Excellence in June. A record 334 students applied this year, the most applications since the program was reactivated in 2022. A volunteer committee of business, labor and education leaders selected winners through a highly competitive process.

Additionally, this year's winners represent:

- 86 graduating high school seniors
- 35 community and technical college students
- 47 legislative districts
- 22 Washington counties
- 69 high schools
- 20 community and technical colleges
- Rural, urban and suburban communities

The Washington Award for Vocational Excellence (WAVE) honors Washington's outstanding career and technical education students. Each of the state's 49 legislative districts can have up to three winners per year—for as many as 147 total annual scholarship awardees. Graduating high school seniors who completed or are in the process of completing a second year in a single CTE pathway are eligible. Community and technical college students who have completed or are in the process of completing a year of professional-technical training are also eligible.
